The future library network

The Sunshine Coast Libraries Network Plan 2019-2041 provides a vision for the future library network and a blue-print for investments.

It also introduces a new service delivery model of five tiers, that reflects the role and function of services, within that hierarchy.

Kenilworth Library has been identified as a Tier 4 Express Library Service.

Express Libraries alternatives include:

- Community library a modest library service in a community or commercial setting
- Library Lounges an unstaffed library service in a community setting
- Book stops a small collection within a community centre, business or general store

- Vending Machines convenient collection and return of popular titles and reservations.
- Library lockers convenient collection and return of reserved items only
