

Note: Words appearing in **bold** have the meaning assigned to them at PART B – DEFINITIONS.

Part A – Particular manners specific to the Action

The following measures must be taken to avoid significant impacts on:

Listed threatened species and communities (sections 18 & 18A)

Listed migratory species (sections 20 & 20A)

CLEARING LIMITS

 To avoid impacts to marine turtles, the person taking the Action must not clear outside the project area.

TIMING OF THE ACTION

2) To avoid impacts to **marine turtles**, the person taking the Action must not undertake **works** within the **marine turtles nesting season**.

SOURCING SAND FOR DUNE RENOURISHMENT/ REPROFILING

3) To avoid impacts to **marine turtles**, in taking the Action, the person taking the Action must not source sand from the landward side of the **highest astronomical tide mark**.

Part B - Definitions

In these particular manners any bolded use of a word or term refers to the below definition of that word or term:

Clear means the cutting down, felling, thinning, logging, removing, killing, destroying, poisoning, ringbarking, uprooting, or burning of vegetation, but does not include weeds (see the *Australian Weeds Strategy 2017-2027*, Commonwealth of Australia 2017 for further guidance).

Highest astronomical tide mark means the boundary represented in Attachment A by the blue dashed line designated "Highest Astronomical Tide (HAT) - 1.188m".

Marine turtles means the EPBC Act listed threatened species *Caretta caretta* (Loggerhead turtle) and *Chelonia mydas* (Green turtle).

Nesting season means the period commencing 1 October in any year and ending 30 April of the following year.

Project area means the location of the Action, represented in <u>Attachment A</u> by the zones: enclosed by the outer edge of red and white dashed line designated 'Pilot Study Site', and the area shaded orange designated the 'Disturbance Footprint'.

Works means the use of an excavator or similar heavy machinery to **clear** or move sand for the purposes of the taking the Action. **Works** does not include any earth moving required to respond to an emergency situation.
