Our Resilient Coast. Our Future.

Between March and June we are focussed on building our understanding of local coastal processes and listening to your experience and reflections about living near our coastline. Read on to find out about what else we have been up to and where you can meet us to have your say.

Understanding local coastal processes

We are currently refining the modelling of erosion potential along the Sunshine Coast Regional Council coastline. Results will inform an update of the Erosion Prone Areas, previously mapped by the Queensland Government. The update will also improve our understanding of areas likely to be impacted by future coastal hazards.

Help decide what a resilient coast will look like in the future

The project team are currently out and about talking with a wide range of government, community and local business stakeholders.

We are calling on our community members to share your own reflections and views on what events have shaped our coastline and what you think a resilient coast should look like in the future.
