Progress and timeline update

Over March and April, the *Our Resilient Coast. Our Future* project team has completed draft technical work to inform an appreciation of:

- Coastal hazard risk (present day to 2100)
- Adaptation options
- Economic implications and opportunities.

An update on this work will be presented to council for their consideration and determination of next steps.



Following council's consideration, discussion on adaptation options with council, the Community Advisory Group, and all stakeholders including the community, is proposed after June 2020.

A suite of strategic and practical actions will be developed to manage and adapt to coastal hazards on the Sunshine Coast.

The draft strategy is due for completion by September 2020.



Engagement process update

The COVID-19 limitations on face-to-face activities require a change to some of the proposed upcoming consultation.

The project team has been developing alternative tools and techniques to assist with facilitating input and feedback on the developing strategy over the coming months.
