

Share Your Story – Neighbour Day 2022 Competition

Sunshine Coast residents are invited to share stories about their neighbourhood and how they have come together before and during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Share a photo and a story (up to 2000 characters) for a chance to win one of 3x \$100 Bunnings Vouchers for your neighbour.

The following Terms and Conditions apply to all entries.

- The competition period opens at 8 am Friday 18 March 2022 and closes at midnight Monday 11 April 2022. Any entry received after the closing date will be deemed invalid. Sunshine Coast Council takes no responsibility for late, lost or misdirected entries.
- Personal information collected by Sunshine Coast Council in the online entry form is used only for the purposes specified and is not passed on to third parties.
- Council is authorised to collect this information in accordance with the *Local Government Act 2009* and other local government Acts. Your personal information is only accessed by persons authorised to do so in compliance with the *Information Privacy Act 2009*. Your personal information is dealt with in accordance with council's Privacy Policy.
- By submitting a photograph with a story of up to 2000 characters and including your demographic information, you have entered into a competition to win the specified prizes on offer as advertised.
- A submitted photograph is evidence of the entrants' consent to these Terms and Conditions.
- All photographic images must be captured within the Sunshine Coast Council Local Government Area boundaries. Please refer to Queensland Local Government Maps for boundary confirmation.
- Photographic entries must not contain any material that is offensive, defamatory, discriminating, obscene, indecent, harassing or threatening or is otherwise unlawful. Any entry that at the absolute discretion of the Council, is deemed to be offensive, discriminatory, defamatory, obscene, indecent, harassing or threatening, will immediately be disqualified from the prize draw and will not be made publicly viewable via the Have your Say Sunshine Coast website. Council's decision in relation to any aspect of this consultation is final. No correspondence and/or discussion will be entered into.
- Photographs and stories will be publicly viewable within 48 hours after submission.
- The winning prizes advertised are:
 - for the 3 winning nominated neighbours – 1 x \$100 Bunnings Voucher each
- To be eligible for a prize you must share a story (up to 2000 characters), provide a photograph of your neighbour/neighbourhood and answer all the required questions on the online submission form.
- No more than one entry per person is allowed.
- Sunshine Coast Council staff can enter the competition but are not eligible to win the advertised prizes associated, including permanent, casual and volunteer staff or family members.
- Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be taken as cash.
- Submissions will be assessed against the competition criteria and winners determined as follows;
 - People's Choice: most liked story
 - Councillors Choice
 - Council's choice: panel of 3 to determine
- The winning entries will be announced on Friday 22 April 2022.
- Results are final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the prize draw.
- Sunshine Coast Council will take no responsibility for prizes not claimed within three (3) months of the draw date.
- Sunshine Coast Council will take no responsibility, if this competition is not capable of running as planned, that is beyond the control of Sunshine Coast Council.
- Sunshine Coast Council reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual, who tampers with the entry process, and to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the prize draw.
- By providing contact information for the entry, it will be deemed as the entrants consent to their name, email and phone details being available to Sunshine Coast Council, in the event that they are a winner, for Council to arrange to send them their prize.

- For entrants under 18 years of age, completion and submission of the survey will be taken as the entrants' parent, carer or legal guardian having given their consent to the entrants' submission.
