

Sunshine Coast Get Ready Schools competition 2021 – Terms and Conditions

The following TERMS AND CONDITIONS apply to all entries:

1. Entry to the Competition is free. Entrants will be responsible for all costs associated with entering the competition, which may include the costs associated with accessing the internet.
2. The Promoter of the 2021 “Sunshine Coast Get Ready” schools’ competition (the competition) is the Sunshine Coast Council.
3. Entry is open to all school students attending a primary school within the Sunshine Coast Local Government area.
4. An entrant must be made up of students from any grade level (Prep to 6) up to a maximum of 5 students per team (Entrant).
5. An Entrant must consist of student/s from grades Prep to 6 from any school located within the Sunshine Coast Local Government Area.
6. Entrants must have the consent of their school and parent/guardian to enter. Consent must be provided by executing and uploading the template document provided by the Promoter. This document must be uploaded at the time of entry submission for the entry to be valid.
7. By making a submission, the Entrant, including their school and parent/guardian, gives council permission to publicly display entered videos online and in any promotional media.
8. Entries can be submitted from 8:30am Monday 1 March 2021 and submissions will not be accepted after midnight Friday 30th April 2021 (“Competition Period”). Any entry received after the expiry of the Competition Period will be deemed invalid. No responsibility is accepted for late, lost, delayed or misdirected entries.
9. A maximum of one (1) video submitted by any one Team entrant is allowed. Multiple entries from a school is permitted.
10. A caption/title of up to 10 words is mandatory to ‘Title’ your entry.
11. A description of up to 250 words is mandatory on each entry submission, describing the **intent** of the video, **how** the students developed the message, and **who** the students engaged with during the development of the video.
12. All video footage must be captured within the Sunshine Coast Council Local Government Area boundaries. Please refer to [Queensland Local Government Maps](#) for boundary confirmation.
13. All entry videos must have a connection to the Sunshine Coast region
14. All entry videos must refer to being prepared and having a plan for **any type of disaster**. Information and ideas may be sought from the Get Ready Queensland website www.qld.gov.au/getready
15. All videos must be uploaded using the official form on the Sunshine Coast Get Ready Schools Competition page of the [Have Your Say Sunshine Coast](#) website
16. Video file uploads must be between 30 seconds in length and less than 200 MB in size; videos must be provided in HD (High Definition) as an AVI file, with an aspect ratio of 16:9.
17. Entries must be the original work of the Entrant.
18. No third party or commercial gallery may enter a video on behalf of an entrant.
19. Entries containing multiple team members will be accepted as one entry and, on the understanding, that each team members contribution is deemed equal.
20. Information on how to enter the competition and prizes form part of these entry terms.
21. Every entry automatically places the Entrants school into the running for the school prize pack.

The school of the **first-place** winning entry will receive:

- Media marketing package: The winning team and their school will work with the Sunshine Coast Council behind the scenes and in front of the camera to deliver Council's 2021 Get Ready television, radio, and social media campaign.
- 100 x Sun Safe school hats with your school's monogram, and Council / Get Ready branding (valued up to \$1,000)

The school of the **second-place** winning entry will receive:

- 100 x Sun Safe school hats with your school's monogram, and Council / Get Ready branding (valued up to \$1,000)

23. Prizes cannot be taken in cash, in full or part, or be withdrawn as cash, in full or part, at any time.
24. Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable or redeemable for cash.
25. Prizes are subject to availability and the Promoter reserves the right to substitute any prize, partly or wholly, it's components with another of equivalent value without giving notice.
26. A submitted video is evidence of the entrant's consent to these Terms and Conditions.
27. Entries must not contain any material that is offensive, defamatory, discriminating, obscene, indecent, harassing or threatening or is otherwise unlawful. Any entry that at the absolute discretion of the Council, is deemed to be offensive, discriminatory, defamatory, obscene, indecent, harassing or threatening, will immediately be disqualified from the Competition. The Promoters decision in relation to any aspect of the Competition is final. No correspondence and/or discussion will be entered into.
28. The entrant must have the written, signed and dated permission of any people appearing in the image submitted. The entrant must be able to produce evidence of permission from subject if requested.
29. Entries will be assessed by a panel of judges selected by the Sunshine Coast Council and by public vote as arranged by the Promoter. The decisions of the judging panel are final and no correspondence and or communication of any kind in relation to the panels' decision will be entered into.
30. Judging Panel: The Sunshine Coast Council will shortlist entries and the Judging Panel will recommend the top 3 submissions based on the following criteria:
 - Creativity – how you include the theme and pre-requisites in imaginative and creative ways.
 - Information – the accuracy and ease of understanding, with a clear message aligned with the Get Ready Queensland 'Planning for Disasters' message. www.qld.gov.au/getready
 - Engagement – how the students have engaged with others within and outside the school community to develop and deliver their message.
31. The assessment of the entries by the panel of judges will provide 70% weighting of the submission score. The remainder 30% of the scoring is decided on the public vote, at a time, location and process as determined by the Promoter.
32. Entrants agree that by entering they authorise the Promoter to use, reproduce and/or exhibit videos entered into the Competition for the purpose of advertising and promoting the competition and/or other Sunshine Coast Council documents, activities, programs and events. The videos may be reproduced in any medium. The Promoter is not required to pay a fee to use, reproduce or exhibit any videos entered in the Competition. The creator of the video will be acknowledged with all published videos. If the video is selected as winner, the entrant will enter an agreement to issue license to the Sunshine Coast Council for a period of ten years. The creator will also retain the right to use the video for their own purposes. All expenses incurred in the submission of the entry are the responsibility of the applicant.
33. Entrants and their parent/guardian and school agree that by entering this competition they authorise the Promoter to use, reproduce and/or exhibit the Entrants image in council's advertising and/or promotional material. The Entrant and their parent/guardian and school agree that he/she/they has/have no interest in copyright of their image and they also understand they are not entitled to financial reimbursement for participation in photographs, video or audio, and/or their subsequent publication.

- 34.** Entrants warrant in submitting a video, that it is their original work and does not violate or infringe (or reasonably be expected to violate or infringe) upon the legal rights of any other person, including material which is protected by copyright, trademark or other intellectual property rights. Entrants must not engage in any unlawful or improper conduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the Competition. By entering the competition each entrant (or where the entrant is a minor, then the parent or guardian) and school indemnifies the Sunshine Coast Council against all loss, damage, costs (including legal costs) or liability whatsoever arising out of or in connection with the entrant's breach of these terms and conditions.
- 35.** Council reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and to disqualify any entry that is not in accordance with the Competition Terms and Conditions.
- 36.** Council reserves the right to cancel or terminate the competition if, for any reason beyond Council's control, the integrity of the Competition or its fairness or security is compromised.
- 37.** Council is not responsible for any additional costs associated with use of the Prize.
- 38.** Council is authorised to collect entrant information in accordance with the *Local Government Act 2009* and other local government Acts. Entrants personal information is only accessed by persons authorised to do so. Your personal information is dealt with in accordance with Council's Information Privacy Policy, available on Council's website.
