John Hotton Park Improvements

Project summary

Sunshine Coast Council is undertaking early planning to improve John Hotton Park, Warana.

The park is an already popular and welldeveloped Local Park providing access to Warana Beach.

A redesign of the current layout could improve the park's function and amenity.

The park contains various facilities including toilets, a playground, barbecue facilities, picnic tables, beach shower, and a beach shelter with filtered ocean views.

Council is seeking feedback on what the community loves about the park and what improvements they might like to see to ensure that any changes made to the park are in line with the local community's values.

Toilet Block

The toilet block in John Hotton Park is scheduled for renewal and the new building will be constructed in the same location as existing.

Construction is due to commence mid-2023.

Coastal Pathway

The future Coastal Pathway will pass through the Warana Foreshore Bushland Reserve, connecting the recently completed Palkana Park section to Buddina.

This path is currently in the final stages of detailed design and has been issued a Development Permit from the State Government.

Although there are no immediate plans or budget to upgrade the park at this time (not including the coastal pathway and toilet block), community feedback will help council plan ahead and seek potential future grant applications and funding opportunities.

Confirm the community's aspirations for the future of the park. Determine the community's priorities for future upgrades to help identify construction stages.

TBC: Construction

No funding commitments for construction form part of this process. Future funding and timing for construction is yet to be confirmed.
